## **New Cities To Get Commuter Service**

The flights over Segment 7 will enable a passenger from an intermediate city to go to Chicago or Detroit in the morning and return home the same day. By the same token, a passenger from Chicago or Detroit will be able to fly to an intermediate city, transact a full day's business, and return home the same evening.

These flights will also provide convenient connections with other North Central Airlines and trunkline flights at the terminal points.

Flights on the new route have been assigned the 800 series with even numbers southbound (in the direction of Chicago) and odd numbers northbound (to Detroit).

# **Detroit's City Airport** Returns To Air Map

-air travelers can again enjoy regular--after eight yearsly scheduled airline service in and out of Detroit's City airport on the northeast side of town.

North Central Airlines June 1 inaugurates eight-flight-daily service between Detroit City airport and Willow Run, the airport used since 1947 by all scheduled airlines serving Detroit.

North Central will be the only scheduled carrier operating be-

tween the two airports.

Operation into Detroit

operation into Detroit City airport will provide through service (no transfer at Detroit's Willow Run airport) on three flights over the airline's Upper

Michigan peninsula route and four over the Chicago route.

An initial schedule of four round-trip flights daily will be operated as extensions of present Chicago and Hyper Michigago and Hyper Michigago.

operated as extensions of present Chicago and Upper Michigan flights to and from Willow Run.
Willow Run is located 32 miles southwest of Detroit, and the City airport is about six miles northeast of downtown. North Central has served Detroit via Willow Run since April, 1953, when the airline inaugurated service between Michigan's lakedivided peninsulas. Cities on the divided peninsulas. Cities on the inter-peninsular route are Lansing and Grand Rapids, Green Bay, Marinette-Menominee, Escanaba, Iron Mountain, Marquette and Hancock-Houghton.

North Central's service be-tween Detroit and Chicago was started May 1 with six flights daily. Intermediate cities on the route are Jackson, Battle Creek, Kalamazoo, and South Bend. Besides offering its passengers

through service to and from Detroit City airport on both routes, the new operation also provides convenient "shuttle" service for passengers from De-troit City airport transferring to and from trunk airline flights at Willow Run.

The service will be conducted on an experimental basis for six months to determine whether or not passenger traffic will be sufficient to justify continuation of scheduled airline service between the two airports, says H. N. Carr, North Central's president.
